

Yankee Chapter Inc. Vending and Camping Terms

Vendors and campers must be current AMCA members

Inside Vending permits are \$50 for each 15-foot by 15-foot space. Electrical service is included.

Outside Vending permits are \$50 for each 20-foot by 30-foot space. Electrical service is not included.

Camping permits:

- \$15 for primitive tent camping. Electrical service not included. Only motorcycles may be parked in the primitive camping area. There will be adequate parking for cars and pick-up trucks just outside the fenced in primitive camping area.
- \$40 per 30-foot x 20-foot RV camping space. Electrical service is not included

115 VAC 20 amp. electrical service: (charged per each electrical cord)

- \$15 for Tent campers
- \$25 for Recreational vehicle/trailer
- Greater electrical service is available by prior arrangement with the Lions Club.

ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS ARE LIMITED. *Please register on line and early to insure you get the electrical connections you want.*

RULE #1: Have Fun and respect others so we can all have fun

Vending is a privilege granted to current AMCA members who sell antique motorcycle related merchandise.

- Merchandise and services are strictly limited to antique motorcycle 35 years or older motorcycles, parts, reproduction parts, literature, services, accessories etc.
- Merchandise which MAY NOT be sold includes motorcycles and parts later than 1983, T-shirts with any questionable wording or pictures, guns, knives, drugs, or paraphernalia related to same, alcoholic beverages, or any AMCA or meet-related T-shirts or novelties.
- Displays must be neat, and grounds left as clean as or cleaner than they were on your arrival.
- For everyone's safety, all canopies, awnings, tents, etc. must be secured (staked, tied, or weighted).
- Vendors must conduct themselves in a business-like manner.
- No profanity or loud music.
- The meet opens for business 8:00 am Friday August 03, 2018 and closes at 7 PM Saturday. Vendors must limit their vending to these dates and times. Clean up must be completed by noon Sunday August 05, 2018.

- Absolutely no arrivals before Tuesday July 31, 2018. Tuesday and Wednesday arrivals may 'camp' in the large grass parking lot outside main gate. Limited electrical service and water connections are available in the parking lot. Terryville Lions Club charges \$20, per day for early arrival camping in the parking area.
- Non AMCA members may camp in designated areas outside the main gate for \$20 per night, plus fee for electrical connection OR better yet join the AMCA and Yankees and camp for free. Camp fires are not allowed outside the fairgrounds.
- Members volunteering two hours or more of their time will be allowed into the fairgrounds starting Wednesday August 01, 2018 to help with set-up and meet co-ordination. Sign up early so you can choose the time slot that is most convenient for you and the club.
- Have Fun and respect others so we all can have fun.
- Vendors and campers must remove all they came with. All sites must be left cleaner than they were found!
- Vendors may enter Thursday August 02, 2018 noon to 8 pm and Friday August 03, 2018 – 8 am to noon.
- Only 1 vehicle will be permitted per vendor space. Additional vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.
- Vendors and campers may move picnic tables for their individual use provided the tables are put back where they were found. It will cost you a \$5 donation to have a Lions club volunteer move the table for you.
- Campers must be current AMCA members and may only camp in designated areas. No open fires are allowed. Individual camp fires are allowed in the type of approved fire pit pictured below.

- Alcohol in moderation only—party elsewhere, quiet time is 10 pm.

- No Exotic pets permitted, dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- Participants under age 16 may only operate motorized vehicles in organized events. Don't bring that mini-bike just for the kids to ride around the event on.
- No refunds will be granted for any reason.
- Vendors must comply with any and all tax rules, collect and forward all taxes and file reports to the appropriate taxing authorities—Vendor agrees to hold the AMCA and The Yankee Chapter harmless from any and all liabilities resulting from the vendor's activities.
- Violations of these rules may lead to removal from the grounds, or.....
